## **“10 Facts About WW II You May Or May Not Know”**

1. On average, for every two minutes of combat on Iwo Jima, three Marines were killed.
2. Americans in Japanese prison camps were put into groups of ten men. They were called “The Ten Brothers”. The reason being if one brother would try to escape, the Japanese would execute the other nine brothers.
3. In 1941 Germany had more tanks and planes than all the armies of the world put together.
4. When the Germans invaded Russia in June, 1941 they captured land two times the size of Germany in one week.
5. A U.S. Marine who fought on Iwo Jima said, “ When I die I know I’m not going to Hell, because I’ve already been there”.
6. British pilot Douglas Bader was a fighter pilot in the R.A.F. (Royal Air Force). In 1931 he had an accident on a training mission and lost both legs. He was fitted with artificial legs and learned to walk again. When the war started in 1939, he used his connections and rejoined the R.A.F. He was in the battle of Britain and flew combat over Germany. In 1941 he was shot down and spent the rest of the war as a P.O.W. He was credited with 22 enemy “Kills”. The most famous pilot in Britain died in 1982.
7. The P-51 Mustang was considered the best U.S. fighter plane in WW II. After the war most P-51’s were auctioned off as surplus for \$2,000.00. Today the plane worth between \$750,000.00 and one million dollars.
8. In the battle of Kiev, U.S.S.R. the Germans captured 750,000 prisoners. Of every 100 prisoners captured only 3 survived to return to the U.S.S.R.
9. In an air battle over and around Saipan in June, 1944, U.S. fighters shot down 373 Japanese planes in eight hours.
10. The German U-boat was “Iron Coffins” by their crews and with good reason. Eight of ten crewman died serving on them.
